

Yorkshire Cadet Trust Grant



Advice for Applicants

Applicants must adhere to the following guidelines when submitting their applications:

Supported activity

Applicants will only obtain grants to:

- Enable cadets to take part in camps, courses and training.
- Enable cadet to take part in sports, games, competitions and adventure training.
- Purchase clothing or equipment to support activities mentioned above.
- Promote the efficiency and/or welfare of cadet units by improving facilities and amenities for training.

Timelines

- Applications must be submitted at least a month before funding is required.

Process

To complete your application you should complete the application form as follows:

- Complete Parts A and B on line and then print the document (Back to back if possible) or print the document first and complete by hand.
- Give the printed application form to your unit/detachment/squadron commander and ask him to give a hand-written endorsement of the application in the space provided.
- Finally, ask your unit/detachment/squadron commander to forward the application up the Chain of Command for validation.
- The "Validating Officer" will forward the application to the Yorkshire Cadet Trust for consideration.

Additional Guidance

The following list of additional guidance and feedback is not exhaustive but can, from time to time, be useful for applicants:

- Ensure that all parts of the Application Form are completed fully.
- Always include a good explanation at Part A5 of why you require a grant and do not submit your application by email
- Ensure that Part B clearly indicates the SCC Unit, ACF County or ATC Wing to whom the payment should be made.
- Make sure you complete the "Declaration" and sign your application as unsigned applications will not be considered.
- The "Endorsement" of the application must be completed by the officer commanding the unit, detachment or squadron, giving clear reasons for support of the application.
- Ensure that the application is "Validated" by:
 - SCC Area or District Officer
 - ACF Commandant or Deputy Commandant
 - ATC Wing or Regional Commander
 - CCF Cadets Branch at 15 (NE) Bde
